LIVE GENEROUSLY

A story of my friend, Leland Wilson, a man who lived generously. In no way do I want to say Lee Wilson or anybody else was a perfect man. The Bible makes that clear in **Romans 3:23 (KJV)**, *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"* Lee treated me like a son, his best friend, but he treated everyone like a special friend, a brother or sister, and was a **kind and generous friend** to all who knew him. In fact, both Leland and Keitha Mae Wilson were kind, generous and a friend to all.

The definition of generous as used as an adjective: Of a person showing a readiness to give more of something, as money or time, than is strictly necessary or expected; or even showing kindness to others. See, I believe if you live generously God will be generous to you! As an adverb generous means: Live in a way that shows a readiness to give more of something, especially money, than is necessary or expected. And generously also says to do it in a way that shows kindness or warmth towards others. When New Creations funds ran out he would always be the first to be generous with us! Example: We had the blocks on the front school building done and the plywood sheathing was done when we just plain ran out of money and in came Lee and said, "What do you need next?" and I said, "We need the felt and shingles for the roof!" and out came an unexpected check to get us going again. Lee knew **2 Corinthians 9:6 (KJV)**, *"But this I say, he which soweth to sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which sow bountifully shall reap bountifully."* Lee & Keitha Wilson not only gave to New Creations (Pastor Tim & Bonnie), they also gave to Abundant Life Crusades (Rev. Tony & Marg Abram), Christian Missionary Outreach (Pastor Mike & Linda Heimsoth), the White-water Valley Railroad and many more. See the Wilson's generosity brought them many Godly benefits like the opportunity to see God bless them to give and give again because of their generosity to others. Their heart was not to be generous and kind to receive, but a pure heart to give to others and God in return gave more money, longer life and blessing with more kindness and generosity. **II Corinthians 9:10-11 (KJV)**, *"Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness; Being enriched in everything to all bountifulness, which cause the through us thanksgiving to God."* God commands and encourages generosity. Vision Waiting Update

It is a hard thing to wait and be patient, but by the time you get this newsletter in January 2019, we are believing we will have our approval for zoning. That will happen on Dec. 27, 2018. In January through March we will do all preliminary work like topography work, building blueprints and building.

Our desire is to start erecting a new building in the spring of 2019. This would be the first phase of our buildings and we are believing to do it debt free. This will be our international headquarters and we'll plant churches, missions and Christian organizations all over the United States and the world. It will also be used as our local church and training facility. Our training facility will train ministers (apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers) according to **Ephesians 4:11: (KJV), "And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some pastors and teachers;"** We will also help those who are called to be worship leaders, administrators, church leaders, helpers, etc. according to **1 Corinthians 12:28: (KJV), "And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues."** They will be prepared to perform God's work according to **Ephesians 4:12-13: (KJV), "And the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ."** We are looking for people called of God to train, to build or to buy churches, start mission organizations, and Christian organizations, such as, Christian schools, boarding schools and various types of ministries to reach the world's lost and win them to Jesus Christ and to train and teach Christians how to reach and teach the world's lost souls.

A Simple Christmas Story


